## IMA State Conference at Kollam

Our branch has been honored with the task of hosting the 61st State Conference on 10th & 11th of November 2018. We have been requesting for the State Conference for the last 3 years, but was awarded the same by a unanimous discussion in the State Council Meeting held at Kodungalloor last November.

Hosting a State Conference of IMA is a challenging task. Kollam branch has the distinction of hosting the State Conference in 1989 (33rd Conference) and in 2002 (45th Conference). (No records exist as to whether we had hosted the Conference earlier). The 1989 Conference was held at Town Hall and 2002 Conference at NN Complex (Sumangali & Mangalya). Both these Conferences were widely acclaimed as the best conference as on date.

We are now hosting the conference after a gap of 16 years. During these years IMA has grown leaps and bounds and the number of participants in the Conference has also increased substantially. We are fortunate that we could get the newly inaugurated "Lalas Convention Centre" for the Conference. The facilities available there is the best in this part of the Country. The by-pass road is scheduled to be opened in August 2018. This makes the convention centre easily accessible from both North and South Kerala.

We have constituted 12 Sub committees for conducting Conference. The Sub Committees have started their work in right earnest. Each of the Sub Committee is a mix of experienced Senior Doctors and new budding talents. ## Sweets Syndrome

A fine young lady in her thirties presented to the Skin OPD with complaints of painful red nodules on the forearm, neck, back and forehead for the past 2 days. She also had shoulder pain and mild fever for past 4 days for which she consulted a local physician and took treatment.



There was a similar episode 5 years back.

General physical examination of the patient revealed no abnormal findings. Local examination showed a erythematous papulovesicular lesion of 5x5 cm on right forearm, small lesion 3 - 4 cm on the face, neck, upper back, chest and lateral aspect of thighs.

She was advised to do a routine blood and urine examination and review.

She was given a Steroid antibiotic combination cream for local application and paracetamol for pain.

Next day the lesions had spread and formed plaques. Blood examination showed increased WBC count and predominance of Neutrophils 88 %. Urine examination was normal. On the picture of sudden onset skin lesions following fever with sudden neutrophilic predominance a diagnosis of Sweets syndrome was made and treated with oral Prednisolone and Dapsone. The patient improved considerably.

Acute Febrile Neutrophilic Dermatosis or Sweets syndrome is named after Robert Douglas Sweet who described it in 1964.

It is characterised by sudden onset tender papules and nodules which coalesce to form large plaques mainly appearing on the face, neck, upper trunk and upper limbs, associated with febrile illness and neutrophilic. The course of the disease is weeks to months without any treatment.

Mainly three types of Sweets syndrome is reported.

- Classic or Idiopathic usually associated with fever, IBD, pregnancy etc.
- 2. Malignancy associated AML etc
- 3. Drug induced like OCPs, Minocycline, Co-Trimoxazole.

Management is with Short course oral and topical steroids, Dapsone, Colchicine, Work up to look for malignancies and supportive therapy.
