#### Parry-Romberg Syndrome

Progressive hemifacial atrophy also known as Parry-Romberg Syndrome is a rare degenerative condition characterized by a slow and progressive atrophy of facial tissues, including muscles, bones, and skin. Onset is usually in the first decade. A higher incidence among women and left side of face is noted.

Clinical features include a sharply demarcated line between normal and abnormal skin known as coup de saber. Alopecia and pigmentation of the involved skin often appear. Oral manifestations include atrophy of half of the lip and tongue, shortening of the body of the mandible and/or ramus of the mandible, retarded tooth eruption, and malformed tooth roots.

Medical therapy includes Methotrexate, PUVA, Mycophenolate mofetil, Cyclosporine, and Cyclophosphamide. Various surgical treatment modalities have also been tried.

# Down Memory Lane.... with Dr. C.v. Prathapan

Most of my services were in the Kerala health services. I had held manyposts, both administrative and clinical. I did administration services as ADMO, ESI MO, FPMO, Casualty MO, RMO, Dy DMO, DMO, Medical Superintendent, ADHS and DHS Kerala state. I was recipient of Good Service from the Government of Kerala. Acknowledging my exemplary service, I was appointed as One Man Commission for job evaluation and career prospect study of Government Doctors and nurses. Introduction of specialty system in Kerala health services isone among my many recommendations.



After retirement, from government services, I had worked as anaesthetist in almost all hospitals of Kollam city mainly Benziger Hospital, Quilon Surgical Centre, Prathiba Hospital, Kumar Hospital, Nani Memorial Hospital, AGC Hospital, NS hospital and so on.

My involvement in IMA branch activities need not be penned here because they are well known to our members. At the state level I was once upon a time considered to be one among the top level state leaders. I had held almost all important positions in IMA except that of State President ship which was already offered to me. However I was personally not in a fair position to accept. You know, during those days, there were no tough contests or election to the post of state president. I was senior vice president of IMA, Chairman of Ethics Committee, Epidemics cell, Research cell, Chairman of board of trustees, SSS Scheme etc. I was vice chairman of Kerala Health Scheme when it was formed. I was the returning officer of state IMA election, CWC member for three years consecutively, member of central council and state executive committee member for many years and so on.

I feel proud and lucky to be a member of IMA Kollam Branch. Traditionally, it is one of the pioneer branches in Kerala State. It stands in the forefront of the involvement of IMA activities. In the past we had great leaders like past National Vice President Dr Thomas Vaidyan and past state President Dr P T Cheriyan. The present leaders of IMA Kollam branch are many whose earnest involvement in IMA activities committed professional work have achieved good name for medical profession in the society.

Medical profession was considered a noble profession. However it is said that now a days the respect earned by doctors by the society is declining. Hospital attacks, attacks on medical professionals and such violence are on the increase. New generation doctors cannot close their eyes on these issues.
